

Highpoint Fellowship seeks summer Youth Intern!

Purpose:

The primary purpose of the internship is to be a learning opportunity through relational ministry to middle and high school students. Interns will spend time in all areas of HPY ministries. This experience provides a chance to gain practical ministry training, work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support, test their gifts and call to vocational ministry, and develop spiritually and theologically.

Compensation for Summer Internship:

\$2,000

-Housing – If intern is not local, housing and some meals will be provided by church members

Requirements:

-Spirituality – Each intern must have a personal and living faith in Jesus Christ. All Highpoint Youth Interns should not only see themselves as spiritual mentors for youth, but as living examples for what living for Christ is like.

-Education – All applicants should have completed their sophomore year in college or two years of vocation if not on a college path.

-Transportation – Each intern should have reliable access to some form of transportation. (Please let us know if this presents a challenge for you)

-Must have clean background

Description/Expectations/Responsibilities:

- Growing personal relationship and commitment to Jesus Christ, the body of Christ, and God's work in the world. Spend regular time in personal Bible study/devotional to maintain your own spiritual health outside of ministry.
- Present the Gospel of Jesus Christ to youth and encourage them in their Spiritual growth
- Observe and gain practical experience in encouraging youth, their families, and ministry volunteers
- Work with Highpoint Youth Ministry staff to plan and carry out activities (summer camp, Grow Groups, Mission Trips, Conferences, weekly programs, special events, etc.)
- Responsible for administrative tasks as needed, including social media content and end of summer photo/video project
- Meet weekly for study, prayer, planning, evaluation and communication
- Lead activities when Highpoint Youth staff is away. Teaching as directed and as opportunities avail themselves.
- Accompany the Youth Pastor on most (or all) summer camps and trips.
- Be the creator and primary lead of at least one youth event during the summer

-Teaching Bible lessons in the Middle School/High School Ministry

- Meet with students in Highpoint Youth outside of regularly scheduled activities and maintain proper boundaries

Additional Responsibilities:

- Language – You will have the responsibility of speaking to our students, parents, church members, staff and everyone you come in contact with the utmost respect and reverence as a Christian. Colossians 4:6 says, “Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt..”
 - What you wear – You should be appropriately dressed whether in the office or outside of the church building.
 - Team – The interns at Highpoint are part of a team. As a team you will learn to work together and work through issues that arise in the program and between yourselves. You are also part of the larger pastoral team, and will be treated as such.
 - Community – The interns will see themselves as part of the community of believers called Highpoint Fellowship. We strive to be real and authentic in our love for Jesus and for each other.
- *Responsibilities may be added or changed to fit the giftedness and particular passions of the intern, as well as to meet unforeseen needs within the youth ministry.
