### WHAT IS THIS TRIP?

#### Our annual Highpoint Youth CIY: MOVE trip!

MOVE is a weeklong High School-only event designed to amplify Christ's call on students' live to become kingdom workers. Students at MOVE not only learn and worship together – they spend quality time with their church youth groups, discovering ways that God will use them to impact the world. General website:

### WHERE IS THE EVENT LOCATED?

University of Nebraska, Lincoln, Nebraska (1400 R St, Lincoln, NE 68588). We will be staying a few different places on the drive up: Sat: Pawnee Ave Church of God (Wichita, KS), Sun: the Parents of a church member's house (Lincoln, NE), Mon through Friday night at the University of Nebraska in the dorms. On the last night (Sat) we will be staying at Overland Park Church of Christ (Overland Park, KS). We will be attending a Kansas City Royals game on that last Saturday!

### WHEN?

Departure: **Saturday, July 8 at 11:00am**

Return: **Sunday, July 16 at approximately 9:00pm**

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

MOVE is intended for students going into ninth grade (graduated eighth graders) through graduated seniors.

### WHAT IS THE COST?

**\$360 before scholarships and Church participation.** Price includes lodging, food (except for 6 fast food meals, 2 sit down meals, and food at the ballpark), activities, bus transportation, t-shirt, and supplies.

### WHEN IS THE PAYMENT DEADLINE?

**FULL PAYMENT IS DUE ON SUNDAY, June 4, 2017**

### WHAT IS THE CANCELLATION REFUND POLICY?

**Before May 24:** Student may cancel for any reason and get a total refund (*minus \$50 non-refundable deposit*)

**May 24 – May 31:** If student cancels, a refund of 50% will be made.

**After June 1:** No refund can be made. Student and family are responsible for full amount.

### WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD BRING TO CIY: MOVE?

Enough money for a maximum of 6 fast food meals AND 2 sit down meals plus whatever offering, shirts, CDs, snacks, and whatever else you may want to purchase. Budgeting is the responsibility of your teen. Bible NOT on your phone (very important, you will use it EVERY DAY), Toiletries, Towel, Clothes, Bathing suit, Water Shoes, Sleeping bag and/or blanket and sheet, Pillow, Notebook/pen, a superhero shirt/outfit.

### WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD NOT BRING?

Alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, weapons (including pocket knives etc.), TVs, DVD players, or movies. This includes watching Netflix or streaming movies while on the trip.

### CAN MY CHILD BRING FOOD OF HIS OWN?

Sure, BUTTTTTTT... There will be plenty of food and snacks at the conference. Your child will have plenty to eat.

### **WHAT ACTIVITIES WILL THERE BE AT CIY: MOVE?**

There's a pool, putting green, open gym, tennis courts, hiking trails, ping-pong, and billiards. And that doesn't include the regular programming, games and tournaments!

### **WHAT SPIRITUAL GROWTH ACTIVITIES WILL BE GOING ON?**

Interactive worship, dynamic preaching, small group study, community building, quiet times, baptisms, and more.

### **WHAT IF MY CHILD WANTS TO BE BAPTIZED AT CIY: MOVE?**

Baptisms are not uncommon at CIY. It is a special place for a student to dedicate their life to Jesus. If your son or daughter wishes to be baptized, we will make every effort to contact you. We understand that we are not close enough for you to have the option to drive to CIY: MOVE to witness the event.
