- 6. What does Jesus reply to the crowd when they confront him, to be their King?
- 7. When the crowd leaves, what does Jesus ask of His Disciples? What was the local people's reaction?

8.	Verses 25-59 Jesus tries to teach them the truth of Who he is and His Kingdom, what was his reply? What did he say our "Work" is? Explain what Jesus means, "I Am the Bread of Life, and how does He compares Himself and Moses?
