Main Point: Mark 3:35

- What makes the list in Acts unique?

v. 21 Please read Mark 3:21 in several different translations and write what you notice. In order to do this, I recommend *biblegateway.com* and put Mark 3:21 in the search box. Once displayed, you should see underneath the verse underlined Mark 3:21 in all English translations – click on it.
