

- 1. Verses 1-6 Where did God place Joseph when in Egypt? How was Joseph blessed?**
- 2. Describe Joseph as a man, and the incident with Potipher's wife, and what were the results? Verses 6 - 16**
- 3. What resulted from the lies of Potipher's wife, and the reaction of Potipher, where did this result in Potipher's actions toward Joseph? (16-18)**
- 4. From verse 21, what do you learn and how is Joseph blessed and become a blessing? (Think! Who is Captain of the Guards?)**
- 5. (chapter 40) Explain the dreams of the Chief Baker, the Wine Steward (Cup Bearer), how did Joseph give God glory in answering their explanation of the dreams?**
- 6. What was God foretelling that would happen to them by these dreams? How were the dreams fulfilled?**
- 7. (ch.41) How long was it after the Cup bearer was back with the King was Joseph still in prison, before the King began to have dreams nobody could explain their meaning. What did he say when he remembered Joseph had been able to explain his dreams. Sharing his experience resulted in Joseph being released, how was he treated by the King.**

- 8. Explain the King's dreams and the meaning God revealed to him by God through Joseph. How old was Joseph now, and what all did the King do for Joseph, setting him up as the governor over the nation.**
  
- 9. With the King giving to Joseph the Egyptian wife Zaphenath, and them having two sons, helped Joseph feel a part of Egypt, and what did he name his two sons? See if you can find the meaning of their names, and what did the names reveal?**
  
- 10. Explain how Joseph succeeded in provided for not only Egypt but all other in that area.**
